

Demolishing of Abundant Unsafe Building Structure at Kannakuddah School

Kannankudah Maha Vidiyalayam is situated in Manmunai West Divisional Secretary division and it is one of the oldest school in the region. This school has 723 children – 355 males and 368 females. One of the two story build in the school premises which was built in 1993 was damaged due to bad weather and conflict during the past. This was abundant after an injury to some of the school children who were in the building. Thereafter several attempts were made by the school authorities to demolish the building as this building seemed to be very risky to the children who passed by the building.

T.Thilashan age 18 years studying in A/L/arts class feels that earlier they felt feared and unsafe to come near this building. The female students used the side way of this building to go to wash room and they too felt unsafe. Now he and his fellow students feels happy and can run about fearlessly. He said thank to his principal and all other like VDO, CF and the Zonal Director this child protection gesture.



Ariyanaygam Krishanthiya age 17 years and studying in grade 12 said that before the demolishing the building they felt unsafe to go near the building. They have been using this building for PT classes but still unsafe and had to move to other place for PT classes. Now she feels safe and protected. They are happy that there is space for them to play. She thanked VDO/CF and the Education Department authorities for demolishing this building and now they are protected.
